

## *The kit you'll need*

- » Vacuum cleaner
- » Bleach
- » White Vinegar poured into a spray bottle
- » Cloth
- » Water
- » Old towels



## *How to clean the lint filter*

First, clean out the lint filter or screen. You should do this after every use to avoid a build-up of lint which could cause a fire.



- 1 Make sure your appliance has cooled down fully.
- 2 Locate the filter, usually inside the door rim or behind a panel at the front of the dryer.
- 3 Remove as much lint as you can with a brush before swiping the screen with a used fabric softener sheet to pick up any lingering pieces.
- 4 Give the filter and the lint trap a once over with a vacuum cleaner to get it extra clean.

## *How to clean a smelly tumble dryer*

- 1 Mix 120ml of bleach to 2 litres of warm water and dip a cloth into the mixture and wring it out thoroughly.
- 2 Use the cloth to wipe the inside of the drum and the door, then leave the door open to dry.
- 3 After it has dried, wipe the drum walls down with just water and leave to dry.
- 4 Spray white vinegar onto a few old towels, put them inside the tumble dryer and run a drying cycle to neutralise any remaining odour.
- 5 Make sure the walls of the dryer are free of bleach before putting any load in to prevent clothes getting damaged.
